



Requests regarding vehicle information by third parties (not the vehicle owner)

Note on use:

1. What is needed from the owner?

The owner must completely fill out information (1) for the verification of the owners, (2) for the power of attorney to submit waivers and (3) and for the limitation of time period, (4) sign the form and (5) attach proof of ownership to the form.

2. When and why is the owner's power of attorney needed?

This power of attorney is needed when a person (hereafter referred to as "Claimant") asserts data subject rights according to GDPR for a vehicle that is owned by a legal person (e.g. GmbH, AG, Limited).

The reason for this is that the claimant's data subject rights are generally limited by the owner's rights if they apply to the same data. For Volkswagen AG to be able to meet the claimant's concern regarding this data without limitation by the owner's rights, the owner would have to consent that Volkswagen AG would disregard their rights when granting the data subject rights of the claimant selected below. For example, in the case of a request for erasure, this would mean that the owner would consent to the erasure of the data.
